



- Arrived 15 January 1779 with his brother Gaspard Falcon at the Port of New Orleans.
- •Was granted land of three arpents frontage on the right bank of the Lafourche near Donaldsonville.
- •By January 1, 1789, Christobal had 20 quarts of corn, 12 cattle, 4 horses, and 16 hogs and 2 slaves.





Maria spoke French but would only speak Spanish if she didn't want you to know what she was saying. If she was hiding something, or talking about something personal, she would say it in Spanish so the children wouldn't understand.

Maria would be sitting by the fireplace with a big apron on with a pocket full of pecans while dipping tobacco but she would never dip in front of anyone. Unfortunately, all of the kids would have to line up to kiss her when they arrived, dreading that her mouth would smell of dipping tobacco. They would recall seeing the dip juice run down the sides of her mouth. Maria wore a long dress and would wipe her mouth on it. She would pretend to wide dust from her dress but it was leftover tobacco.

- I. Diego Falcón, nacido en 1508 en Montehermoso, a tres leguas de Coria, poblador de la Gran Canaria a poco de su conquista, como consta de una información practicada en 1575 a favor de Diego Flores de San Juan, en que figuró como testigo, siendo a la sazón Capitán de Infantería española de la Gente de Guerra de la Isla y Alcalde Real de Teror, estuvo casado con Maria Dominguez, y consta que fué su única hija:
- II. Leonor Falcón, nacida en Las Palmas, bautizada en el Sagrario-Catedral el 2 de febrero de 1542, casada en Teror con el Capitán Juan Lorenzo Castellano, hijo de Juan Castellano y de Juana Lorenzo, naturales y vecinos de la misma villa. De Leonor Falcón procedieron en este matrimonio dos hijos, que mantuvieron constantemente, a usanza de aquellos fiempos, el apellido de su madre, y se llamaron:

1. Diego Falcón, tronco de la rama de la Casa de Falcón en la ciudad de Telde. Murto 1626

- Catalina Falcón, que formó a su vez la rama de Las Palmas y sigue esta línea.
- (?) 3. María Dominguez, casada en Arucas en 1625 con Gaspar Barreto, hijo de Francisco Barreto y de Francisca Núñez.
- III. Catalina Falcón, que vivió en Teror, en el sitio denominado Cuesta de Falcón, casada con Gaspar Hernández, hijo de Roque Hernández, vecino de Teror, y de Elvira Gutiérrez, que otorgó su testamento ante Lorenzo Palenzuela, el 20 de agosto de 1574.
- * Gaspar Hernández y Catalina Falcón no tuvieron más que un hijo, a saber:
- ** IV. Pedro Falcón, nacido en Teror y vecino de El Palmar, donde casó, el día 5 de octubre de 1614, con Isabel Suárez Gil, hija de Bartolomé Gil Pulido y de Mayor de Ascanio, su mujer legítima, «cristianos viejos oriundos de Castilla que se establecieron en Teror», según consta de las informaciones de su Hidalguía y calidad practicadas por sus descendientes, como luego más extensamente referiremos.

En 1673 falleció en el mismo pueblo Pedro Falcón, llamado el Viejo, cuyo testamento pasó el 17 de diciembre de 1672 por ante Andrés López, escribano público, y dejó sólo dos hijas, que fueron:

1. Doña Juana Suárez Falcón, que estaba viuda del Capitán Juan López Travieso el año 1665, en que otorgó sus últimas disposiciones ante Diego Álvares de Silva. El Capitán Travieso falleció en Argel cautivo de los moros.

2. Doña María Suárez Falcón, que continúa la filiación.

V. Doña María Suárez Falcón, nacida en Teror y bautizada en su iglesia parroquial de Nuestra Señora del Pino el dia 7 de agosto de 1616, vivió casada en la ciudad del Real de Las Palmas con el Alférez de la Gente de Guerra de las Milicias Isidro González Carrasco, como consta del testamento de éste ante Juan Báez Golfos, en 25 de noviembre de 1660, y que sus padres fueron Sebastián González Carrasco y Ana González, vecinos de Las Palmas.

Doña Maria falleció, sin haber testado, en 15 de abril de 1652, dejando los hijos siguientes:

1. Don Juan González Falcón, que sigue.

- Don Pedro González Falcón, Capitán de Infanteria española, bautizado en el Sagrario-Catedral el 27 de abril de 1644, que formó la Casa de los Falcón en la villa de Guía, casando en ella, a 26 de agosto de 1663, con Doña Juana de Ariñez Merino y Béthencourt, de la primera Nobleza del país, hija de Marcos Merino de Béthencourt y de Doña Luisa de Riverol y Lugo. 








Falcon Migration in Europe

- Gaspard Falcon was granted 3 arpents of land on the right side of Bayou Lafourche. By January 1, 1789, Gaspard had 4 quarts of rice, 12 quarts of corn, 4 cattle, and 12 hogs.
- •On 3 March 1793, Juan Truxillo sells to Gaspar Falcon for \$200.00, a tract of land containing 3 arpents front, located on the right bank of Bayou Lafourche: bounded by Domingo Chavaille; below by Juan Albarat

Francisco Eulalio Falcon

- •Served in the 6th Regiment (Italian Guards Battalion), European Brigade Militia in the Civil War
- •The formation of the famous European Brigade resulted, largely from unnaturalized Europeans residents in the city, for the preservation of order and for the defense of New Orleans, and was composed of four regiments of infantry, to which was attached one independent company of infantry and one troop of cavalry.
- •Based on correspondence between the War Dept in Washington DC and Francis Falcon, his name in the Confederate roster was listed as 'Francisco Falconi'. This misspelling most probably due to serving in the European Regiment, Italian Guard Battalion, and those who submitted his name in the Confederate roster. This issue caused him and his second wife problems in getting pension payments due to military service.


Joseph Julien Falcon Sr.

- •He was a cane planter and was on the Ascension Parish Police Jury from 1916 to 1920. He had a nice plantation home in Brusly McCall.
- •During his life, he broke one of his toes so badly that in his later years, anyone could move the toe around, oscillate it any which way. The toe would just flop around.
- •Stewart Falcon told a story how during the Civil War, as a teenager Joseph was hiding behind a tree and a Union soldier shot at Joseph, severing a finger tip.

- •Children: He had seven sons serving in the service during WW2

- •Simon was a man who liked people. You couldn't go to his house without eating something. He just wouldn't let you.
- •Any kind of function that had people at it, like weddings, funerals, etc. he was there. He would love to tell funny stories and people would laugh.
- •He lived in a house with a metal roof. He said "Whenever it rained, that's how they made all their children".
- •The most likable person anyone would meet. He took in families during the depression.
- •During his funeral wake, over a 1000 people attended with a line of people around the block.





1804-1810 Lafourche Map - I have run across an old map which was published in the Louisiana Genealogical Register, December 1988, which shows families living around the Donaldsonville area right after the Louisiana Purchase. This map is invaluable to those researching Islenos history. It shows the land plots given to both the Islenos and the Acadians in Louisiana. Feel free to share with others.




